

## **Production of construction materials for January-April 2024.**

The volume of production of construction materials in Kazakhstan for January-April 2024 amounted to **326.2** billion tenge, which in nominal terms is **6%** lower than the same period in 2023 (*347.1 billion tenge*).

The index of physical volume of production in January-April 2024 amounted to **101.1%**. Growth in physical terms is observed in the following goods:

- slag wool, mineral wool (+64.7%)
- prefabricated concrete structures (+16.3%);
- refractory products (+13.2%);
- prefabricated concrete structures (+9.8%);
- gypsum board (+10.9%);
- stone worked for monuments (+3.6%).

Exports of construction materials products for January-March 2024 compared to the same period of 2023 increased by **23.4%** and amounted to USD **58.5** million. US DOLLARS. In physical terms, the volume of exports decreased by 1% to **258.9** thousand tons, while for the same period last year was at the level of 261.6 thousand tons. The main top export countries are Russia, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan.

Imports of construction materials to the domestic market in January-March 2024 amounted to **USD 232.2 million**. In physical terms, the volume of goods amounted to 551.8 thousand tons decreasing by **11.5%** against the same period of 2023. The main top importing countries are Russia (*40.8%*), China (*25.3%*) and Uzbekistan (*5%*).

In January-March 2024, the market volume of construction materials in Kazakhstan amounted to **\$669.4 mln**. **In January-March 2024**, the market volume of construction materials in the Republic of Kazakhstan amounted to USD 669.4 mln, where the **share of OTP accounts for 65.3%**, the **share of imported products 34.7%**.

The largest volumes of production in value terms for January-April of this year come from Astana city (with the region's share of 14% in total production), Almaty region (9.4%) and Karaganda region (9.1%).
