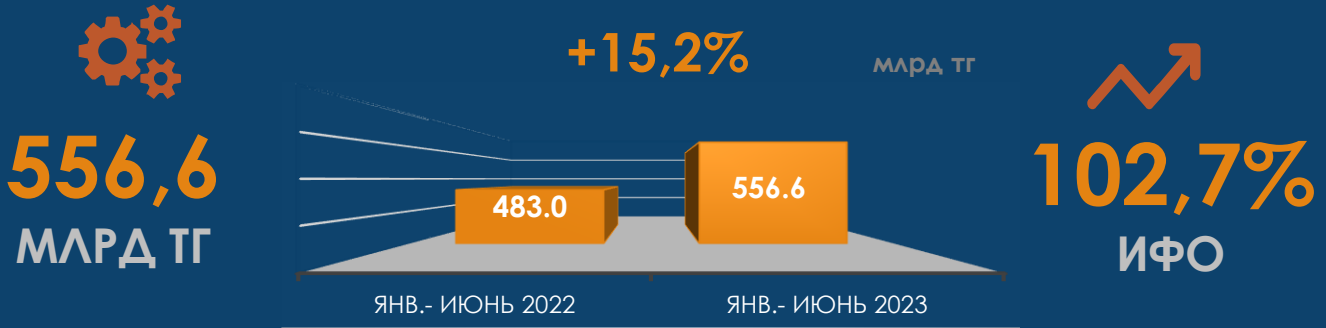

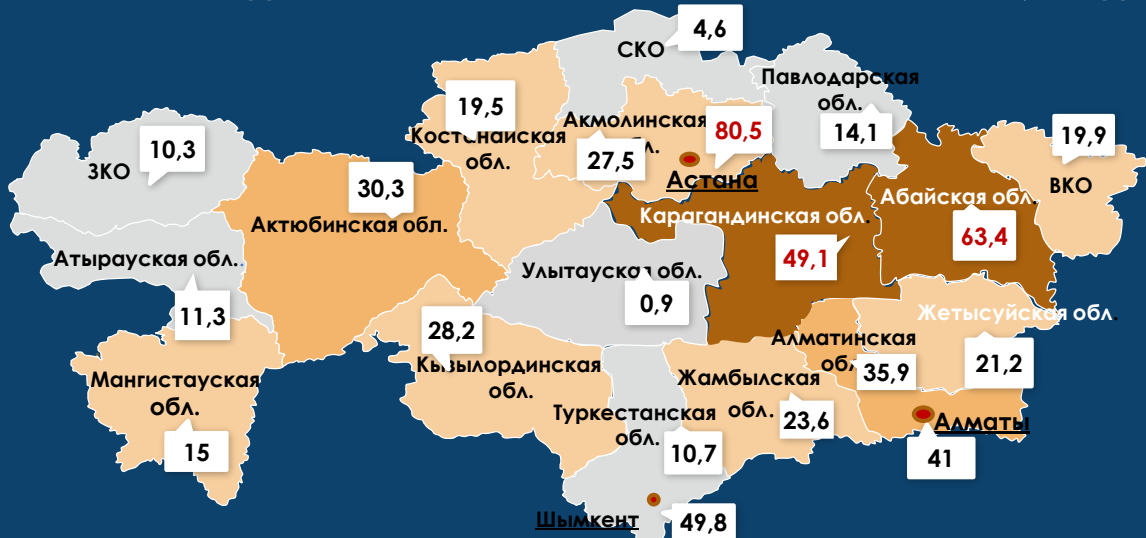

## **Infographic for January-June 2023 for the building materials industry**

Infographic for January-June 2023 for the building materials industry

The Republic of Kazakhstan produced **556.6 billion tenge** worth of building materials in January-June 2023, which is 15.2% higher than the same period in 2022 (**483 billion tenge**).

In January-June 2023, the **index of physical volume of production** was **102.7%**. In terms of physical volume, refractory products (+12.6%), non-refractory ceramic bricks (+35.6%), silicate and slag bricks (+2.4%), and mortar (+13.7%) showed growth.

**The exports of building materials products** in January-May 2023 increased by 43.7% over the same period in 2022 and amounted to USD 100.1 million. **Physically, exports increased by 3.5% to 550 thousand tons**, compared to 531.3 thousand tons for the same period last year. Russia, Uzbekistan, and Kyrgyzstan are the top exporting nations.

Compared to January-May 2022, building materials imports to the domestic market decreased by 7.2% to **USD 442.9 million**. As a result, the volume of goods decreased by 29% from January-May 2022 to 1,074.9 thousand tons. In terms of imports, Russia, China, and Uzbekistan are the leading countries.

During January-May 2023, the Republic of Kazakhstan's **building materials market accounted for 1,340.6 million US dollars**, with OTP accounting for 67% and imported products accounting for 33%.

**According to value terms**, for January-May of the current year, Astana accounted for 14.5% of total production, followed by the Abay region (11.4%), and Shymkent (9%).
