



## Mechanical engineering for January-September 2023

The volume of **mechanical engineering** production in the Republic of Kazakhstan for **January-September 2023** compared to the same period in 2022 in monetary terms increased by 39% and amounted to 2,951 billion tenge.

Compared with January-September 2022, the **PVI of mechanical engineering** products increased by **127.3%**. According to the **physical volume index**, the following sectors experienced increases:

PVI of production of electrical equipment (120.1%),

PVI of production of other vehicles (125.7%),

PVI of production of machinery and equipment not included in other categories (114.8%),

PVI of production of computers, electronic and optical equipment (106.6%),

*PVI of production of cars, trailers and semi-trailers (140.8%).* 

The monetary value of the **mechanical engineering exports** for January-August 2023 was **USD 2,728.5 million**, a **44%** increase over the same period in 2022. Each sector has seen noticeable growth, in nominal terms.

There were **six main exporting countries** during this timeframe: Russia (66%), Uzbekistan (6%), Kyrgyzstan (4%), Turkmenistan (3%), and Tajikistan (1%)

Mechanical engineering products were imported for USD 17,665 million in January-August 2023, up 52% from the same period in 2022. Vehicles with internal combustion engines 1500-3000 cm3 account for the largest share of imports (the share of goods in total imports was 6.0%), motor vehicle bodies (5.2%), smartphones (4.7%), internal combustion engines larger than 3000 cm3 (2.9%), reciprocating piston engines with cylinders greater than 1000 cm3 (2.6%), etc.).

The major importing countries are China (32%), Russia (11%), South Korea (7%), the United States (7%), and Japan (5%).

The industry is **concentrated** in Kostanay region, Almaty city, Nur-Sultan city, Akmola city, Pavlodar city and Karaganda city.
