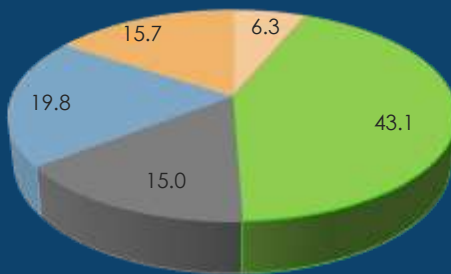

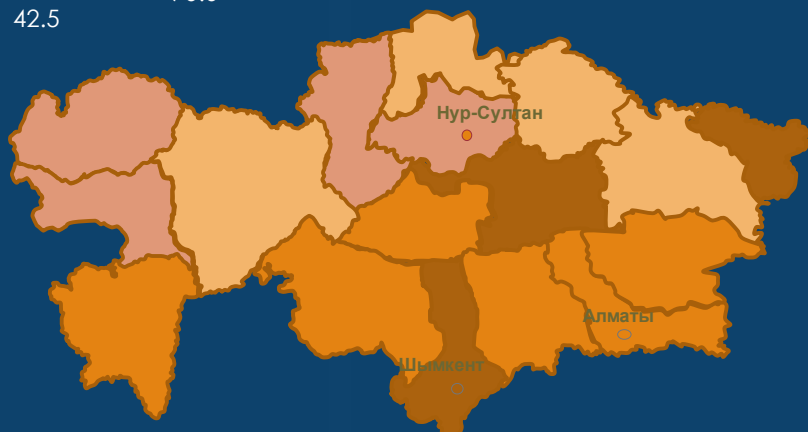
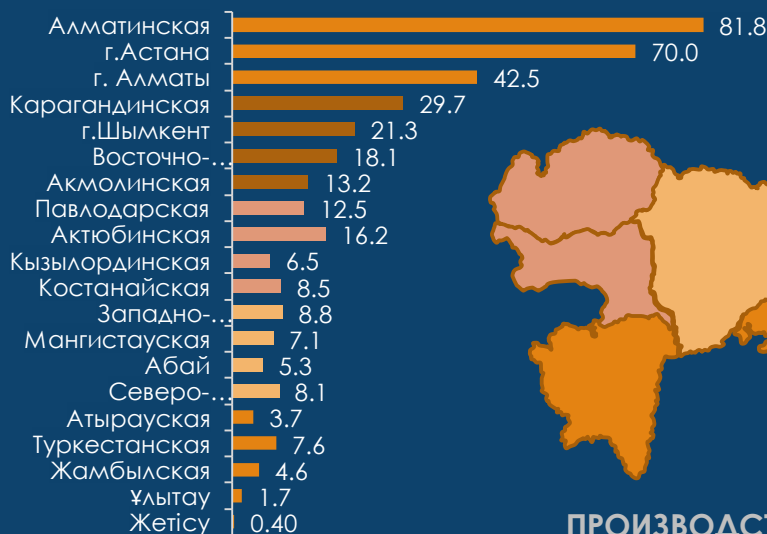

January-October 2023: Rubber and plastic products

Rubber and plastic product production for January-October 2023 increased by **10.9%** from 2022 to **367.7 billion tenge**.

During the analyzed period, plastic plates, sheets, pipes and profiles accounted for **43.1%** of rubber and plastic product production, construction plastics accounted for **19.8%**, other plastic products accounted for **15.7%**, plastic packaging for goods accounted for **15%**, and other rubber products accounted for **6.3%**..

The physical volume index for the analyzed period was 105.5%. A major increase in production volumes in terms of physical volume can be found in the manufacture of household items, tableware, kitchenware, toiletries and other items made of plastic (+0.7%), bags and bags (including conical ones) made of polyethylene (+1.6%) and pipes, tubes, hoses and hose fittings made of plastic (+4.2%). Consumption of these goods has grown as a result of increased consumer demand.

Rubber and plastic exports for **January-September 2023** increased by **2.2 times** compared to the same period in 2022, reaching **276.9 million US dollars**. Main export destinations were **Russia (79.3%)**, **Kyrgyzstan (8.2%)**, and **Uzbekistan (5.5%)**.

The **imports** of rubber and plastic goods during January-September 2023 amounted to **1,876.6 million US dollars**, an increase of 27.2% compared to 2022. In terms of volume, **China was the major supplier of rubber goods (28.8%)**, **Russia was the second largest supplier (28.3%)**, and **Germany ranked fourth (4.6%)**.

As of January-September 2023, rubber and plastic products generated **2,325.2 million US dollars (1,053.1 billion tenges)**, which was **16.8%** more than that in 2022. The share of OTPs decreased by 7 percentage points and amounted to 19% despite an increase in production (+ 12.1%), due primarily to higher imports (+27.2%). In total, 81% of products were imported.

Rubber and plastic products are produced in the following regions during January-October 2023: **Almaty region (22.2%)**, **Astana (19%)**, **Almaty (11.6%)**, **Karaganda region (8%)**, **Shymkent (5.8%)**.
