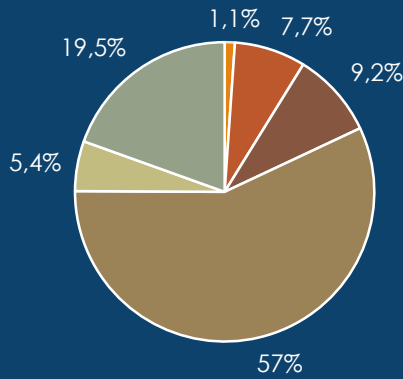

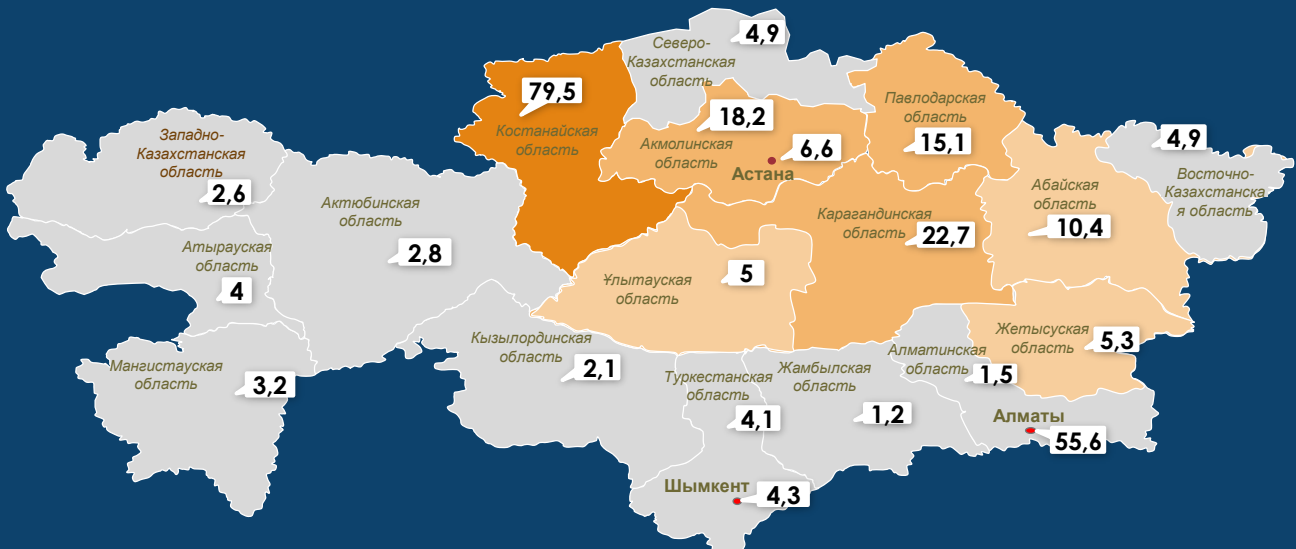

Mechanical engineering for January 2024

The volume of mechanical engineering production in the Republic of Kazakhstan in January 2024 compared to the same period in 2023 in monetary terms increased by 23.4% and amounted to 261.5 billion tenge.

The IFI of mechanical engineering products for January 2024 compared to January 2023 amounted to 117.7%. The following indicators of the physical volume index were achieved in the following sectors:

IFO production of electrical equipment (144.3%),

IFI production of other vehicles (151.5%),

IFI production of machinery and equipment not included in other categories (85.8%),

IFO production of computers, electronic and optical equipment (174.5%),

IFO production of cars, trailers and semi-trailers (130.0%).

Exports of mechanical engineering products for January-December 2023 compared to the same period in 2022 in monetary terms decreased by 2% and amounted to **USD 3,850 million**, which is largely due to a reduction in re-exported products.

Main export countries for this period: Russia (66%), Uzbekistan (7%), Kyrgyzstan (4%), Turkmenistan (4%), Tajikistan (1%)

Imports of mechanical engineering products in January-December 2023 compared to the same period in 2022 in monetary terms increased by 31.3% and amounted to **USD 26.429 million**. In the structure of imports, the main share falls on vehicles with internal combustion engines 1500–3000 cm³ (the share of goods in total imports was 6%), bodies for motor vehicles (4.9%), smartphones (4.5%), aircraft and aircraft (2.6%), vehicles with internal combustion engines over 3000 cm³ (2.6%).

Main importing countries: China (33%), Russia (12%), South Korea (7%), Germany (7%), United States (7%).

The industry is characterized by high territorial concentration in the Kostanay region, the cities of Almaty and Astana, Akmola, Pavlodar and Karaganda regions.
