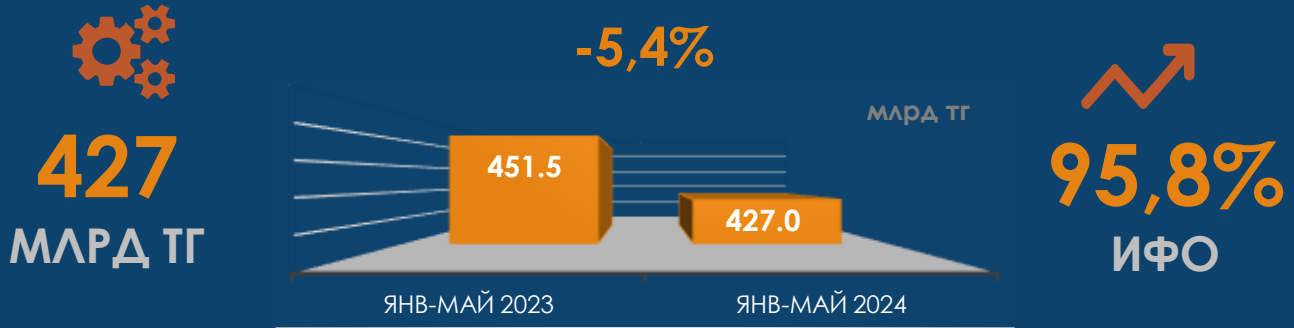

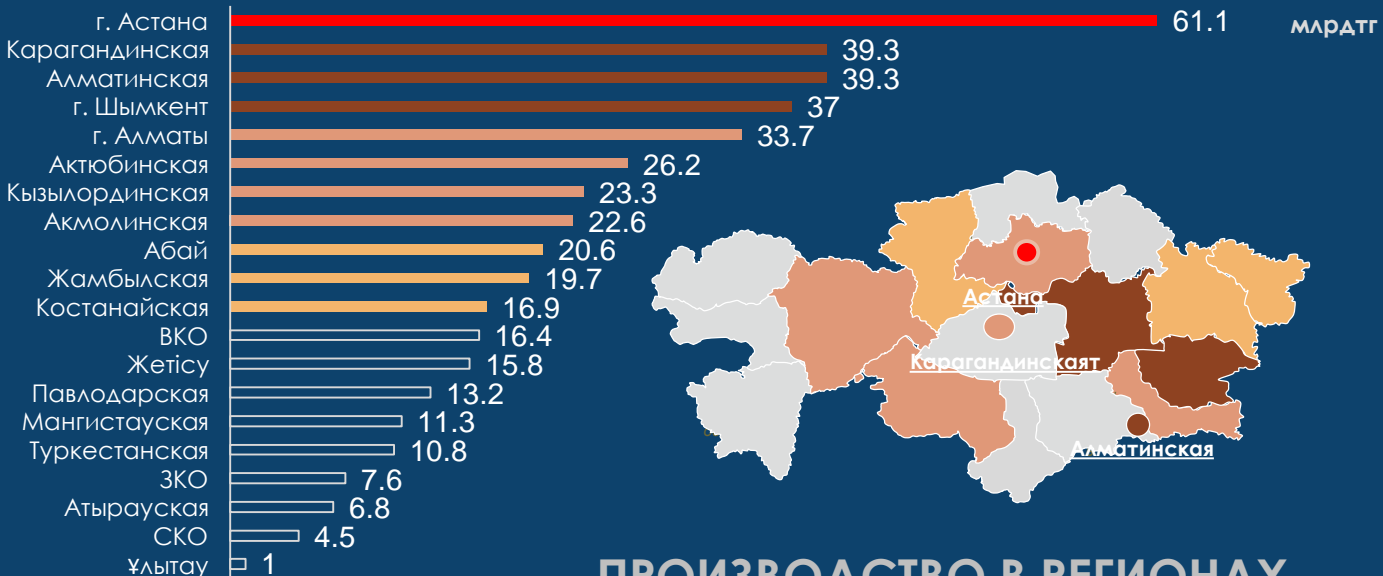

ПРОИЗВОДСТВО В РЕГИОНАХ

Production of construction materials for January-May 2024.

The volume of production of construction materials of RK for January-May 2024 amounted to **427** billion tenge, which in nominal terms is **5.4%** lower than the same period of 2023 (*451.5 billion tenge*).

The index of physical volume of production in January-May 2024 amounted to **95,8%**. Growth in physical terms is observed for the following goods:

- slagwool, mineral wool (+58.5%)
- prefabricated concrete structures (+16.7%);
- refractory products (+16%);
- gypsumboard (+6.5%).

Exports of construction materials products for January-April 2024 compared to the same period of 2023 increased by **17.4%** and amounted to USD **81.1** million USDOLLARS. In physical terms, the volume of exports increased by **0.9%** to **400.1** thousand tons, while for the same period last year was at the level of 396.7 thousand tons. The main top export countries are Russia, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan.

Imports of construction materials to the domestic market in January-April 2024 amounted to **USD 321.9 million**. The import of construction materials to the domestic market in January-April 2024 amounted to **\$ 321.9 million**, showing a decline in relation to the same period of 2023 by **8.6%**. In physical terms, the volume of goods amounted to **781.4** thousand tons, decreasing by **12.2%** against the same period of 2023. The main top importing countries are Russia, China and Uzbekistan.

In January-April 2024, the market volume of construction materials in Kazakhstan amounted to **\$966.7 mln**. The largest volumes of production in value terms for January-April of this year fall on Astana city (with the region's share of 14.3% in total production), Karaganda region (9.2%) and Almaty region (9.2%).
